there your heart will be also. 'Be dressed for action and have your lamps lit;

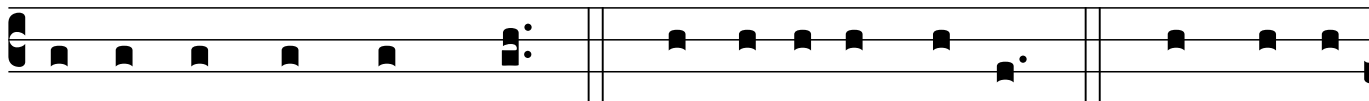
be like those who are wait-ing for their master to re-turn from the wedding

banquet, so that they may o-pen the door for him as soon as he comes and

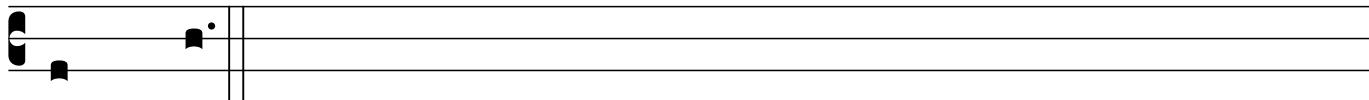
knocks. Blessed are those slaves whom the master finds a-lert when he comes;
