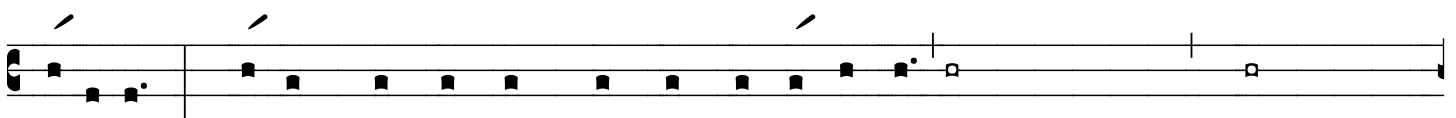
The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming



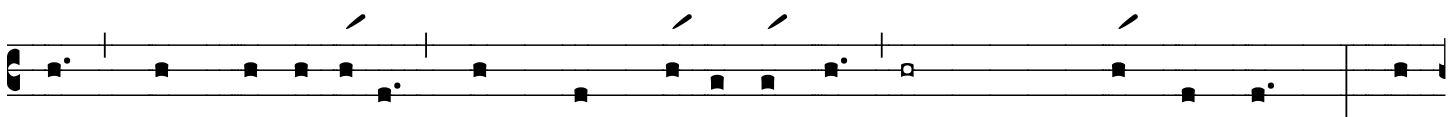
to Je-ru-sa-lem. <sup>13</sup> So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shout-



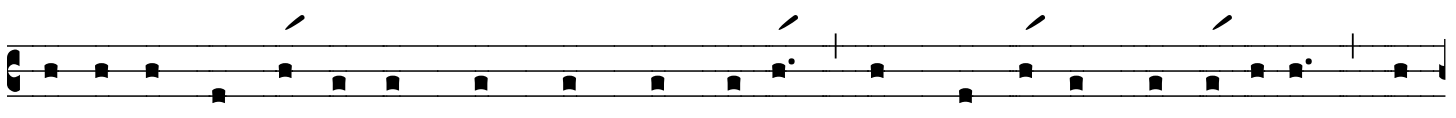
ing, “Ho-san-na! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord—the King of



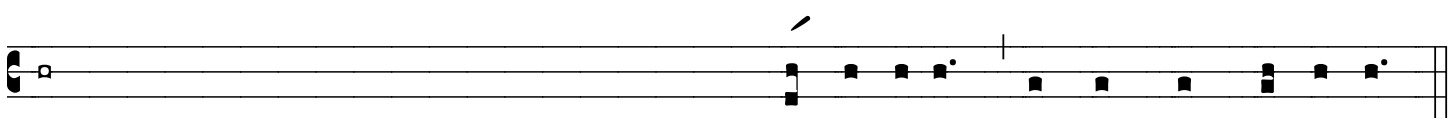
Is-ra-el!” <sup>14</sup> Je-sus found a young don-key and sat on it; as it is written: <sup>15</sup> “Do not be a-



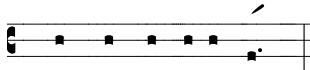
fraid, daugh-ter of Zi-on. Look, your king is com-ing, sitting on a don-key’s colt!” <sup>16</sup> His
