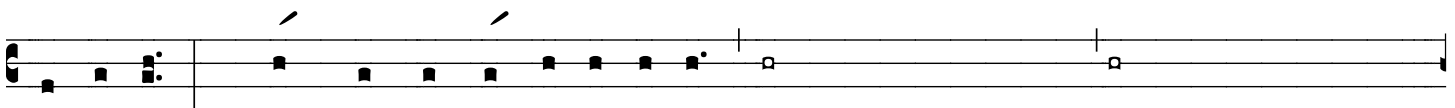
size of a mus-tard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be up-root-ed and plant-ed in



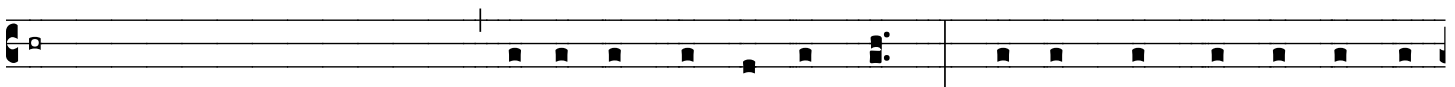
the sea,’ and it would o - bey you. 7 “Who among you would say to your slave who has just



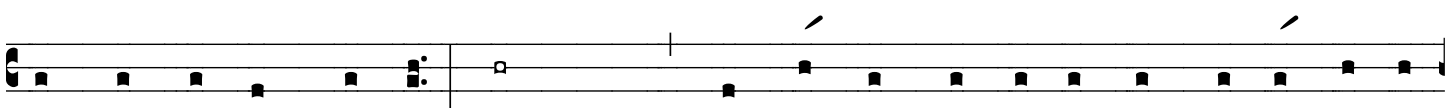
come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, ‘Come here at once and take your place at



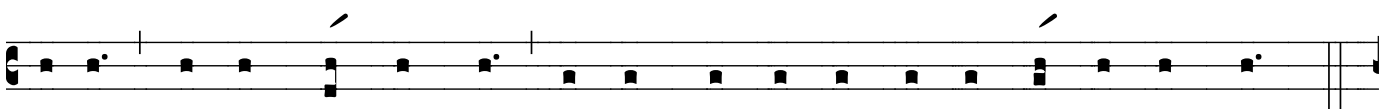
the ta-ble’? 8 Would you not rath-er say to him, ‘Prepare supper for me, put on your apron and
