the hear-ing of the people, he entered Ca-perna-um. A centu-ri- on there

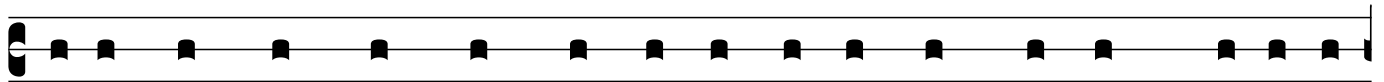
had a slave whom he valued highly, and who was ill and close to death.

When he heard about Je-sus, he sent some Jewish elders to him, asking him

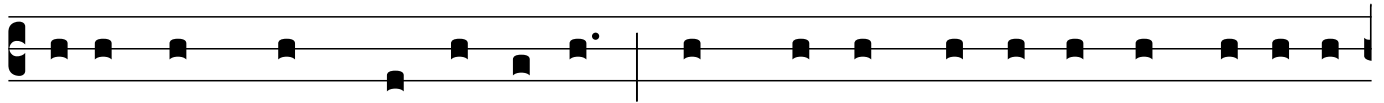
to come and heal his slave. When they came to Je-sus, they appealed to

him earnestly, say-ing, 'He is worthy of hav-ing you do this for him, for

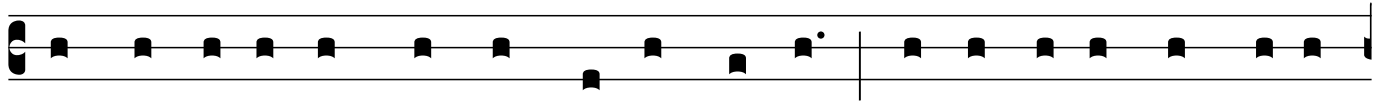
he loves our people, and it is he who built our syn-a-gogue for us.' And



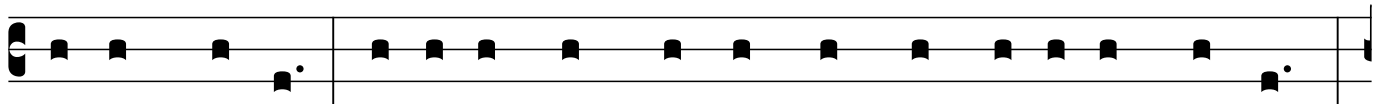
Je-sus went with them, but when he was not far from the house, the centu-



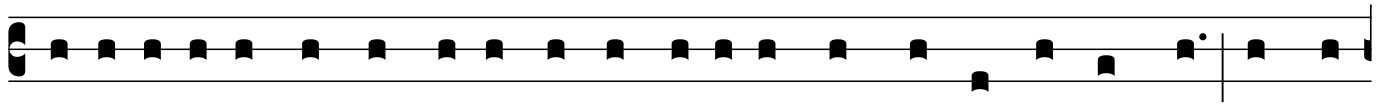
ri-on sent friends to say to him, ‘Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am



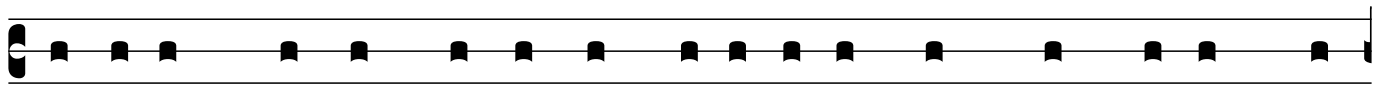
not worthy to have you come under my roof; therefore I did not pre-sume



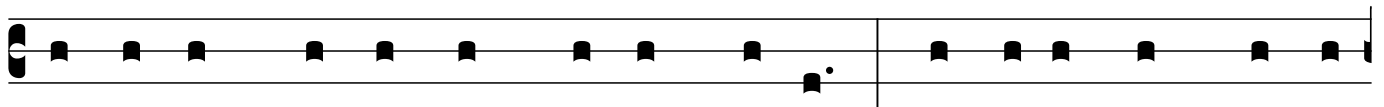
to come to you. But only speak the word, and let my servant be healed.



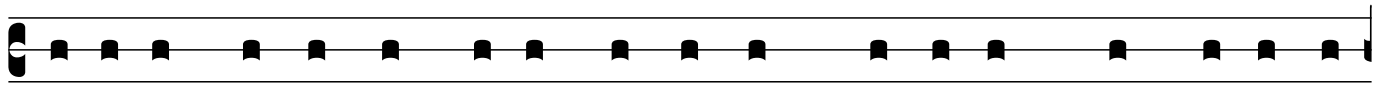
For I also am a man set under author-i-ty, with soldiers under me; and I



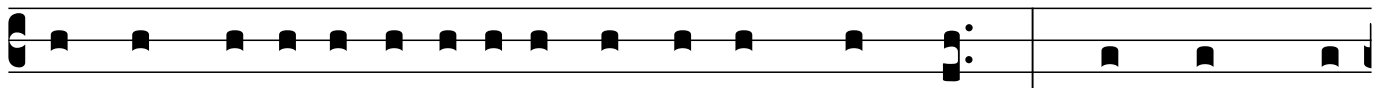
say to one, “Go”, and he goes, and to an-other, “Come”, and he comes, and



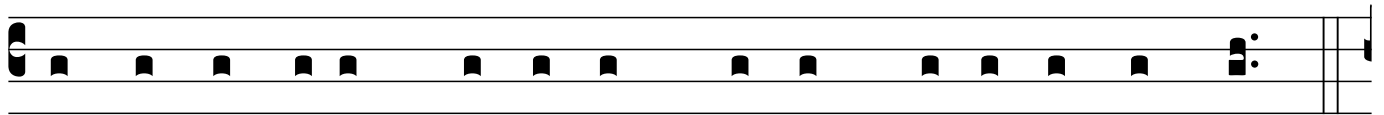
to my slave, “Do this”, and the slave does it.’ When Je-sus heard this he



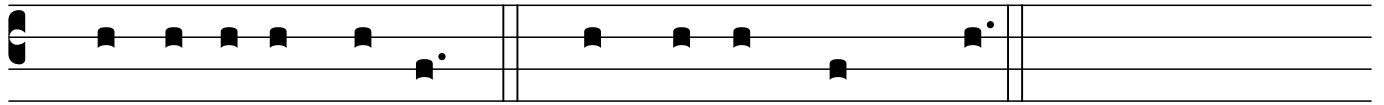
was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd that fol-lowed him, he said, ‘I
