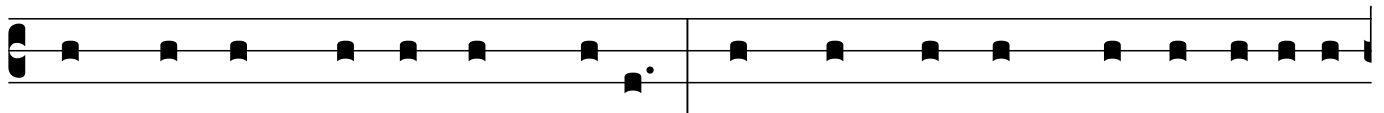
R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* Now after he rose early on the first day of



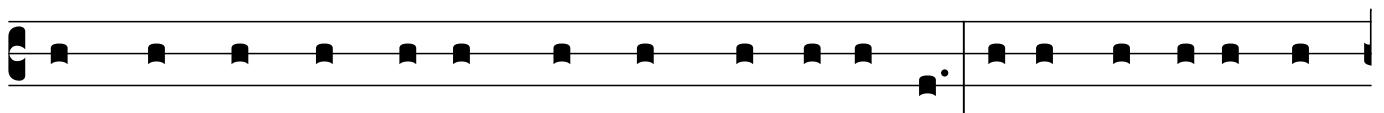
the week, he appeared first to Mar-y Magda-lene, from whom he had cast



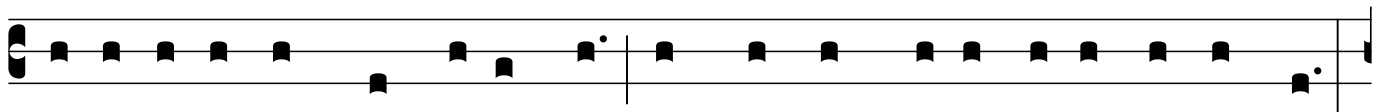
out sev-en demons. She went out and told those who had been with him,



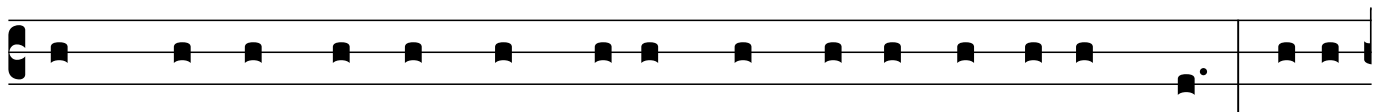
while they were mourning and weeping. But when they heard that he was a-live



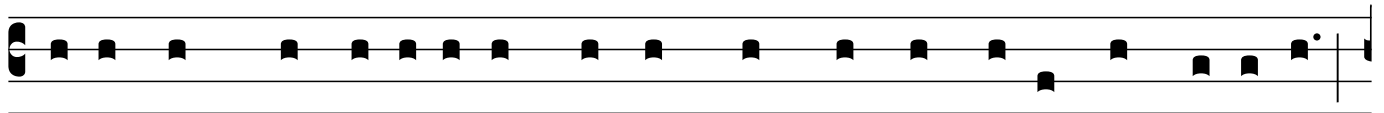
and had been seen by her, they would not be-lieve it. After this he appeared



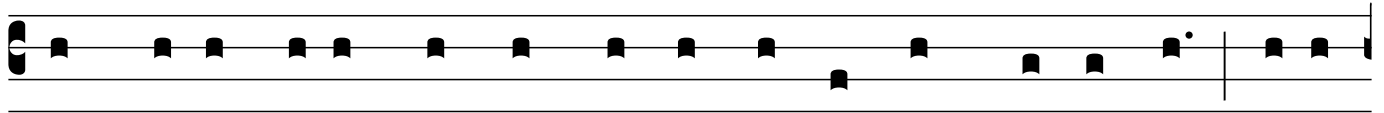
in an-other form to two of them, as they were walking into the country.



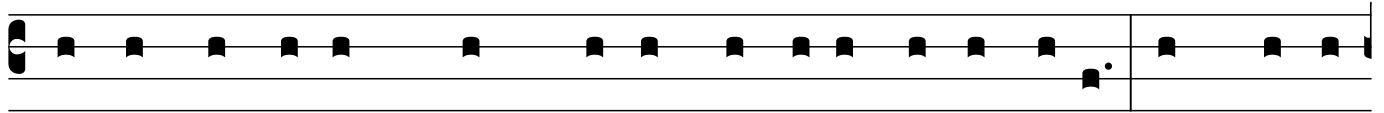
And they went back and told the rest, but they did not be-lieve them. Lat-er



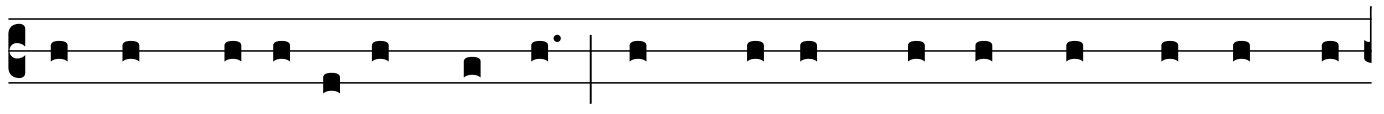
he appeared to the e-lev-en themselves as they were sit-ting at the table;



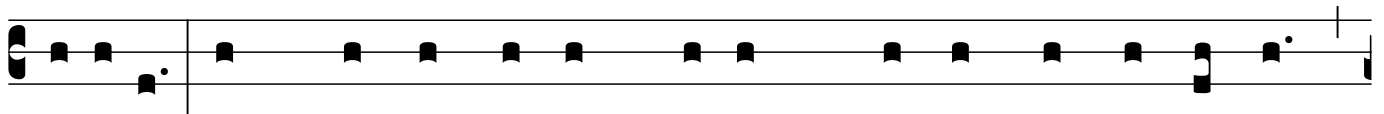
and he upbraided them for their lack of faith and stubbornness, because



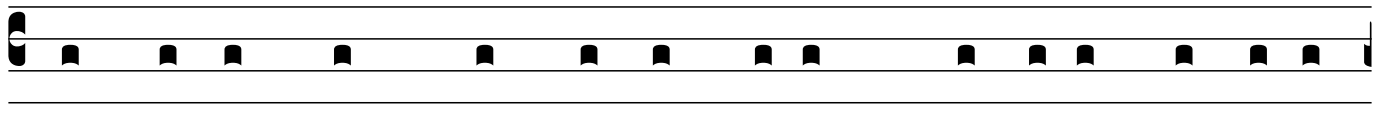
they had not be-lieved those who saw him after he had ris-en. And he said



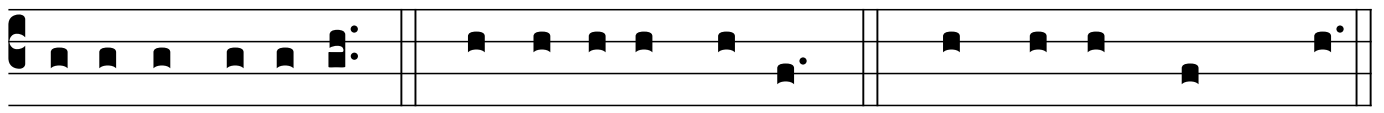
to them, 'Go into all the world, and proclaim the good news to the whole
