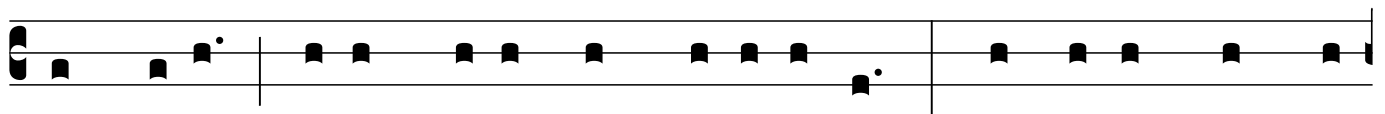
℞ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* On the way to Je-ru-sa-lem Je-sus was go-



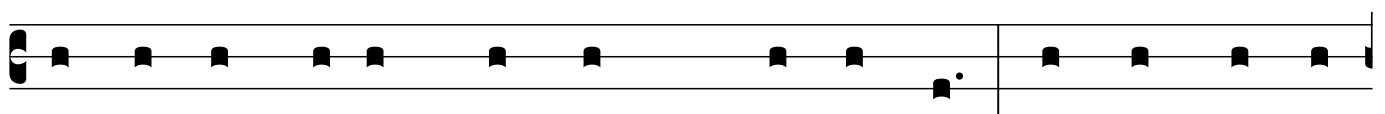
ing through the region between Samar-i- a and Gal-i-lee. As he entered



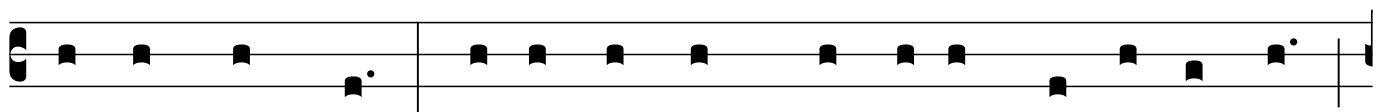
a vil-lage, ten lep-ers approached him. Keeping their dis-tance, they called



out, say-ing, 'Je-sus, Master, have mercy on us!' When he saw them, he



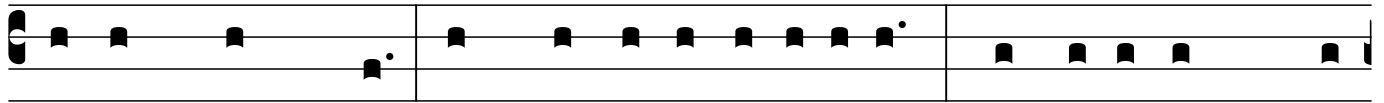
said to them, 'Go and show yourselves to the priests.' And as they went,



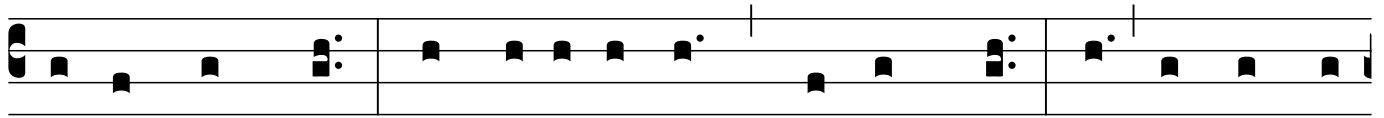
they were made clean. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed,



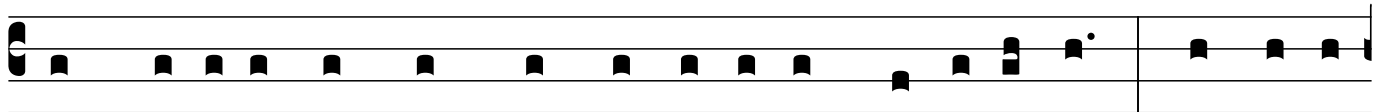
turned back, prais-ing God with a loud voice. He prostrat-ed himself at Je-sus'



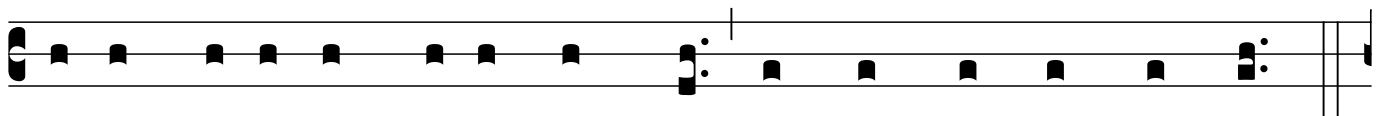
feet and thanked him. And he was a Samar-i-tan. Then Je-sus asked, 'Were



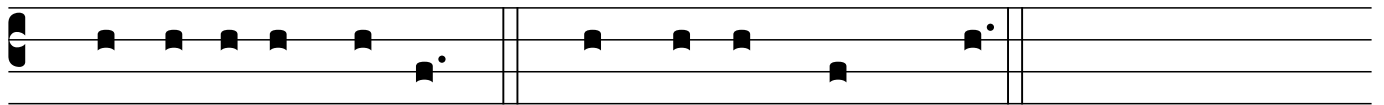
not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? Was none of them
