Pro-claim the great-ness of the Lord our God! who is the Ho-ly One.




1. The Lord is King; let the peo-ple trem-ble; he is enthroned upon the cherubim;

3. Let them confess his *Name*, which is great and awe-some; he is the Ho-ly One.




4. "O migh-ty King, lover of justice, you have es-tab-lished eq-ui-ty;




Go and make disciples of all na-tions; I am with you always, to the end of the age.



6. Oh, that I could make them known and tell them! but they are more




than I can count. **Refrain** 7. In sac - rifice and offering you take no plea-sure

and so I said, "Be-hold, I come. 9. In the roll of the book it is written concerning me:




'I love to do your will, O my God; your law is deep in my heart.'" **Refrain**




10. I *proclaimed* righteousness in the *great* congre - ga - tion; behold, I did not restrain my lips;


Psalm 100

Mode 6 


We are his peo-ple and the sheep of his pas-ture.




1. Be joy-ful in the *Lord*, all you lands; serve the Lord with gladness and come before his



pre-sence with a song. **Refrain** 2. Know this: The Lord himself is God:




he himself has made us, and we are his; we are his people and the sheep of his pas-ture. **Refrain**
