


Annunciation (March 25) Years A, B, C
Psalm 40:5-10 (alt.)

Mode 2 **Refrain**



Be - hold, I come to do your will, O God.

5. Great things are they that you have done, O Lord my God! how great your wonders
and your plans for us! There is none who can be com - pared with you.

6. Oh, that I could make them known and tell them! but they are more
than I can count. **Refrain** 7. In sac - rifice and offering you take no plea - sure
