


The Visitation (May 31)

Mode 4 **Refrain**




Let the Name of the Lord be blessed from this time forth for ev - er - more.



1. Hal - le - lu - jah! Give praise, you servants of the Lord; praise the Name of the Lord.




4. The Lord is high above all na - tions. and his glory a - bove the hea - vens. **Refrain**




5. Who is like the Lord our God who sits en - throned on high but stoops to behold the hea - vens and the earth?

7. He sets them with the prin - ces, and the prin - ces of his peo - ple.




8. He makes the woman of a child - less house to be a joyful moth - er of chil - dren. **Refrain**


