Mode 5 


The hea - vens de - clare the glo - ry of God.




1. The hea - vens declare the glory of God, and the firmament shows his han - di - work.




2. *One day* tells its tale to an - oth - er, and *one night* imparts knowledge to an-oth-er. **Refrain**




3. Al - though they have no words or lan - guage, and their voi - ces are not heard,



4. Their sound has *gone out* into *all* lands, and their message to the ends of the world. **Refrain**




5. In the deep has he set a pavilion for the sun; it *comes forth* like a bridegroom out of his chamber;
it rejoices like a cham - pion to run its course.




6. It *goes forth* from the uttermost edge of the heavens and runs *about* to the end of it a - gain;
