

Vigil for the Eve of the Baptism of Our Lord
The Anointing of David
Psalm 2:1-8

Mode 2 **Refrain**



You are my Son: this day have I be-got - ten you.

1. Why are the nations in an up - roar? Why do the peoples mut - ter emp - ty threats?

2. Why do the kings of the *earth* rise up in revolt, and the princes plot to-ge-th - er, against the Lord and *against* his A-noint-ed? **Refrain** 3. "Let us break their yoke," they say; "let us *cast* off their bonds from us." 4. He whose throne is in heaven is laugh - ing; the *Lord* has them in de - ri - sion. **Refrain** 5. Then he speaks to them in his wrath, and his *rage* fills them with ter - ror. 6. "I myself have set my king upon my holy hill of Zi - on." **Refrain** 7. Let me announce the decree of the Lord; he said to me, "You are my Son; *this* day have I be - got - ten you.
