Mode 2 **Refrain**

2. Bless the *Lord*, O my soul, and forget not all his ben - e - fits. **Refrain**

3. He for - gives all your sins and *heals* all your in - firm - i - ties;

4. He redeems your life from the grave and crowns you with mercy and lov-ing kind-ness; **Refrain**

5. He sat - isfies you with *good* things, and your youth is renewed like an ea - gle's.

6. The *Lord* executes right-eous-ness and judgment for all who are op - pressed. **Refrain**

7. He made his *ways* known to Mo - ses and his works to the children of Is - ra - el.

8. The *Lord* is full of compassion and mer-cy, slow to anger and of great kind-ness. **Refrain**

9. He will *not* always ac - cuse us, nor will he keep his anger for ev - er.

10. He has *not* dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our wick-ed-ness. **Refrain**

11. For as the heavens are high above the earth, so is his mercy great upon those who fear him.

12. As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our sins from us. **Refrain**

13. As a father cares for his chil-dren, so does the *Lord* care for those who fear him.

14. For he *himself* knows whereof we are made; he remembers that we are but dust. **Refrain**

15. Our days are like the grass; we flourish like a flow - er of the field;

16. When the *wind* goes over it, it is gone, and its place shall know it no more. **Refrain**

and his righteousness on chil - dren's chil-dren; 18. On those who keep his cov - e - nant
