


A Vigil on the Eve of Baptism

Psalm 25:3-9


Mode 8 **Refrain**




Your paths, O Lord are love and faith-ful-ness, to those who keep your cov-e-nant.




3. Show me your ways, O Lord, and teach me your paths. **Refrain**




4. Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation;




in you have I trusted all the day long. **Refrain** 5. Re-mem-ber, O Lord, your compassion and love,




for they are from ev-er-last-ing. 6. Remember not the sins of my youth and my trans-gres-sions;

8. He guides the humble in doing right and teaches his way to the low-ly. **Refrain**



Mode 8 **Refrain**



The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Ja-cob is our strong-hold.



1. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trou-ble.

2. Therefore we will *not fear* though the earth be moved, and though the mountains be toppled
into the depths of the sea; 3. Though its waters rage and foam,
and though the mountains tremble at its tu - mult. **Refrain** 5. There is a river
whose *streams make* glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High.

6. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be over - thrown; God shall help her
at the break of day. 7. The nations *make* much ado, and the kingdoms are sha - ken;
God has spoken, and the earth shall melt a - way. **Refrain** 9. Come now and look
upon the works of the Lord, what awesome *things* he has done on earth.

10. It is he who *makes* war to cease in all the world; he breaks the *bow*,
