The Lord is my light and my sal - va - tion.




1. The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom then shall I be a - fraid?



2. When evildoers came upon me to eat my flesh, it was they, my foes and my adversaries, who stum-




bled and fell. **Refrain** 3. Though an army should encamp a - gainst me,



yet my heart shall not be a - fraid; 4. And though war should rise up a - gainst me,




yet will I put my trust in him. **Refrain** 5. *One* thing have I asked of the Lord;




*one* thing I seek; that I may dwell in the house of the *Lord* all the days of my life;




6. To behold the *fair* beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his tem - ple. **Refrain**
