



Ending a Pastoral Relationship

O Lord, your word is ev - er - last - ing.





and my ankles do not give way.






1. Hear my teaching, O my peo - ple; incline your ears to the words of my mouth.




2. I will open my mouth in a par - a - ble; I will declare the mysteries of an - cient times.



3. That which we have heard and known, and what our *forefathers* have told us, we will *not* hide from




their chil - dren. 4. We will recount to generations to come the praiseworthy deeds and the power of the Lord,




and the wonderful works he has done. 5. He gave his decrees to Jacob and established a law for Is - ra - el,




which he commanded them to teach their chil - dren. 6. That the generations to come might *know*,




and the children yet un - born; that they in their turn might tell it to their chil - dren;
