The Lord re - mem - bers that we are but dust.


8. The Lord is full of compassion and mer - cy, slow to anger and of great kind - ness.

10. He has *not* dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our wick - ed - ness. **Refrain** 11. For as the heavens are high above the earth, so is his mercy great upon those who fear him. 12. As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our sins from us. **Refrain** 13. As a father cares for his chil - dren, so does the *Lord* care for those who fear him. 14. For he himself knows whereof we are made; he remembers that we are but dust. **Refrain**

5. My *soul* waits for the Lord, more than watchmen for the morn-ing, more than watchmen for




the morn-ing. 6. O Israel, wait for the Lord, for with the *Lord* there is mer - cy;
