


To - day is born our Sa - vior, Christ the Lord.

2. Sing to the Lord and bless his Name; proclaim the *good* news




of his sal - va - tion from day to day. **Refrain** 3. De - clare his glory among the na - tions




and his wonders a - mong all peo - ples. 4. For great is the Lord




and greatly to be praised; he is more to be feared than all gods. **Refrain**




5. As for all the gods of the nations, they are but i - dols; but it is the Lord who

7. As - crite to the *Lord*, you families of the peo - ples; ascribe to the *Lord* hon - or and pow - er.




8. Ascribe to the Lord the honor due his Name; bring offerings and come in - to his courts.
