1. Lord, who may dwell in your tab - er - na - cle? who may abide up - on your ho - ly hill?

2. Whoever leads a blameless life and does what is right, who speaks

the truth from his heart. **Refrain** 3. There is *no* guile upon his tongue;

he does no evil to his friend; he does *not* heap contempt up - on his neigh - bor.

4. In *his* sight the wicked is re - ject - ed, but he honors those who fear the Lord. **Refrain**

5. He has sworn to do no wrong and does not take back his word.

6. He does *not* give his money in hope of gain, nor does he take a bribe a - gainst the in - no - cent.

7. Whoever does these things shall nev - er be o - ver - thrown. **Refrain**
