6. He shall *come* down like rain upon the *mown* field, like showers that wa - ter the earth.


7. In *his* time shall the righteous flou - rish; there shall be abundance of peace

11. All kings shall *bow* down be-fore him, and all the nations do him ser-vice. **Refrain**




12. For he shall deliver the poor who *cries* out in dis-tress, and the oppressed
