

My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth.




1. I lift up my eyes to the hills; from where is my help to come?




2. My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth. **Refrain**



3. He will *not* let your foot be moved and he who watches over you will




not fall asleep. 4. Behold, he who keeps watch over Israel

it is he who shall keep you safe. 8. The Lord shall watch over your going




out and your coming in, from *this time* forth for ever more. **Refrain**


1. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his mercy en-dures for ev - er.

4. Remember me, O Lord, with the favor you have for your peo - ple, and visit me




with your sav - ing help; 5. That I may see the prosperity of your elect and be glad
