




Tract: Psalm 129: 1-4 (5-8)

5. Let them be put to shame and *thrown* back, all those who are ene-mies of Zi - on.




6. Let them be like grass upon the house-tops, which withers be - fore it can be plucked;



7. Which does *not* fill the hand of the reap-er, nor the bosom of him who binds the sheaves;




8. So that those who go *by* say not so much as, "The *Lord* pros - per you.


