


In your light, O God, we see light.

10. Continue your loving-kindness to those who know you, and your favor to those




who are true of heart. **Refrain** 11. Let not the foot of the proud come near me,

1. Lord, hear my prayer, and let my cry come be - fore you; *hide* not your face from me




in the day of my trou - ble. 2. Incline your ear to me;

so that I forget to eat my bread. 12. But you, O Lord, endure for ev - er,




and your Name from age to age. 13. You will arise and have compassion *on* Zion,
