


Proper 26 Year A (SC Track)

1. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, and his mercy endures for ever.




2. Let *all those* whom the Lord has redeemed proclaim that he redeemed them from the



hand of the foe. **Refrain** 3. He gathered them out of the lands;




from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.



4. Some wandered in desert wastes; they found no way to a




city where they might dwell. 5. They were hungry and thirsty;
