



Mode 5 **Refrain**




You crown the year with your good - ness, O Lord.




1. You are to be praised, O God, in Zi - on; to you shall vows be per -

by the holiness of your tem - ple. 5. Awesome things will you show us in your righteousness,




O God of our sal - va - tion, O Hope of all the ends of the *earth*
