Mode 7 **Refrain**

4. For the word of the Lord is right, and all his works are sure. 5. He *loves* righteous - ness and jus - tice; the loving-kindness of the *Lord* fills the whole earth. **Refrain**

6. By the word of the Lord were the hea - vens made, by the breath of his *mouth*

all the hea - ven - ly hosts. 7. He gathers up the waters of the ocean as

in a wa - ter - skin and *stores* up the depths of the sea. **Refrain**

8. Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all who dwell in the *world*

stand in awe of him. 18. *Behold*, the eye of the Lord is upon those who fear him,

on those who wait up - on his love, 19. To pluck their lives from death,

and to feed them in time of fa - mine. **Refrain** 20. Our soul waits for the Lord;

he is our help and our shield. 21 *Indeed*, our heart re - joi - ces in him,

for in his holy Name we put our trust. 22. Let your loving-kindness, O Lord,

be up - on us, as we have put our trust in you. **Refrain**
