Psalm 85: 1-2, 8-13



of your peo - ple and blotted out all their sins. **Refrain**


8. I will listen to what the *Lord* God is say - ing, for he is speaking peace

grant pros - per - i - ty, and our land will yield its in - crease. 13. Righteousness shall






