


First Sunday in Lent Year B

who keep your cov - e - nant.

1. To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul; my God, I put my trust in you;
let me not be humiliated, nor let my enemies tri - umph o - ver me.

2. Let none who look to you be put to shame; let the treacherous
be disap - point - ed in their schemes. **Refrain** 3. Show me your ways, O Lord,
and teach me your paths. **Refrain** 4. Lead me in your truth and teach me,
for you are the God of my salvation; in you have I trusted
all the day long. **Refrain** 5. Re - mem - ber, O Lord, your compassion and love,
for they are from ev - er - last - ing. 6. Remember not the sins of my youth
and my trans - gres - sions; remember me according to your love and for the sake
of your good - ness, O Lord. **Refrain** 7. Grac - ious and upright is the Lord;

therefore he teaches sin - ners in his way. 8. He guides the humble in doing right
and teaches his way to the low - ly. **Refrain**

Tract: Psalm 91: 1 (2,3) 4, 11-12

1. He who dwells in the shelter of the *Most* High, abides under the shadow
of the Al - mighty - y. 2. He shall say to the Lord,
"You are my refuge and my strong - hold, my God in whom I put my trust."
3. He shall deliver you from the snare of the hun - ter and from the dead - ly pest - i - lence.
4. He shall cover you with his pinions, and you shall *find* refuge under his wings;
his faithfulness shall be a shield and buck - ler. 11. For he shall give
his angels *charge* ov - er you, to keep you in all your ways.
12. They shall bear you in their hands, lest you dash your foot a - gainst a stone.
