


Fifth Sunday in Lent Year B

Cre - ate in me a clean heart, O God.


1. Have mer - cy on me, O *God*, according to your lov - ing - kind - ness;

8. Purge me from my *sin*, and I shall be pure; wash *me*, and I shall be clean in - deed. **Refrain**




9. Make me hear of joy and glad-ness, that the body you have brok - en may re - jice.



10. Hide your face from my sins and *blot out* all my in - i - qui - ties. **Refrain**




11. Cre - ate in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a *right* spi - rit
