
How dear to me is your dwell - ing, O Lord of hosts!




7. Lord God of *hosts*, hear my prayer; hearken, O God of Ja - cob.



8. Behold our defender, O God; and look upon the face of your A - noint - ed. **Refrain**




9. For *one* day in *your* courts is better than a thousand in my *own* room,
