


A-rise, O Lord, in - to your rest-ing place, you and the ark of your strength.


1. Lord, re - member Da - vid, and all the hard - ships he en - dured;




2. How he swore an oath to the Lord and vowed a vow to the Mighty One of Ja-cob: **Refrain**




3. "I will *not* come under the roof of my house, nor *climb* up in - to my bed;




4. I will not allow my eyes to sleep, nor let my eye - lids slum - ber;




5. Until I find a place for the Lord, a dwelling for the Mighty One of Ja-cob." **Refrain**



6. "The *ark!* We heard it was in Eph - ra - tah; we found it in the field of Je - a - rim.




7. Let us go to *God's* dwell-ing place; let us fall upon our knees be-fore his foot-stool." **Refrain**

10. For your servant Da-vid's sake, do *not* turn away the face of your A-noint-ed. **Refrain**




11. The Lord has sworn an oath to Da - vid; in truth, he will not break it.

17. I will clothe her priests with sal - va - tion, and her faithful people will re - joice and sing.




18. There will I make the horn of David flour - ish; I have prepared a lamp for my A - noint - ed.




19. As for his  *enemies*, I will clothe them with shame; but as for him, his crown will shine." **Refrain**
