and is a - fraid. **Refrain** 5. The moun-tains melt like *wax* at the presence of the Lord,


at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth. 6. The heavens declare his right - eous - ness,

11. Light has *sprung* up for the right-eous, and joyful gladness for those who are




true - heart - ed. 12. Rejoice in the *Lord*, you right - eous,


