

6. It *goes* forth from the uttermost edge of the heavens and runs about to the end of



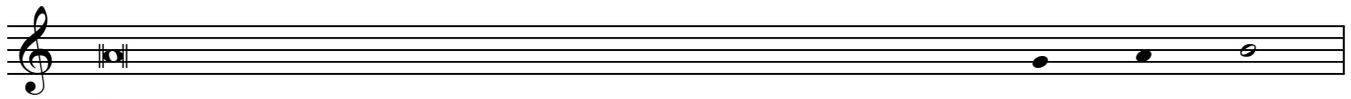

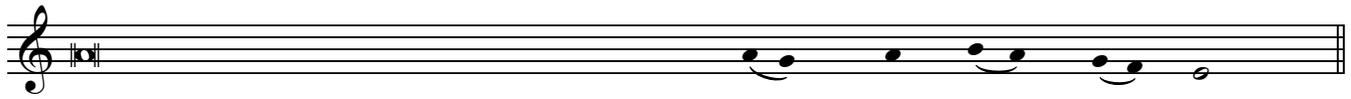
7. The law of the Lord is perfect and re - vives the soul;



the testimony of the Lord is *sure* and *gives* wis - dom to the in - no - cent.



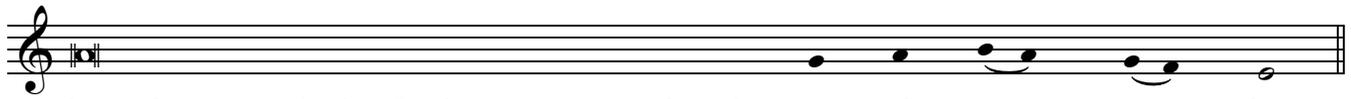
8. The statutes of the Lord are *just* and re - joice the heart;

10. More to be desired are they than *gold*, more than much fine gold, sweeter far than honey,




than hon - ey in the comb. 11. By them also is your ser - vant en - light - ened,




and in keeping them there is great re - ward. **Refrain** 12. Who can tell how often




