Put your trust in the Lord and do good.



do not fret yourself; it *leads* on - ly to e - vil. **Refrain** 10. For e - vildoers shall be




cut off, but those who wait upon the Lord shall pos - sess the land.




11. In a little while the wick - ed shall be no more; you shall *search* out their place,
