


As the deer longs for the wa - ter - brooks, so longs my soul

appear before the pre - sence of God? 3. My tears have been my *food* day and night,




while *all day* long they say to me, "Where now is your God?" **Refrain**




4. I pour out my soul when I think on these things: how I went with the multitude







who is the help of my coun - te - nance, and my God. **Refrain**


