




the price of our life.




1. Hear this, all you peoples; hearken, all you who dwell in the world, you of high



degree and *low*, rich and poor to - geth - er. 2. My mouth shall speak of wis - dom,




and my heart shall meditate on un - der - stand - ing. **Refrain** 3. I will incline




my ear to a pro-verb and set forth my rid - dle up - on the harp. **Refrain**



4. Why should I be a - fraid in e - vil days, when the wickedness of those




at my heels sur - rounds me, 5. The wickedness of those who put their
