






Be joy-ful in God all you lands.




1. Be joy-ful in God, all you lands; sing the glory of his Name;
sing the glo-ry of his praise.




2. Say to God, "How awe-some are your deeds!
because of your *great* strength your enemies cringe be-fore you.




3. All the *earth bows*
down be-fore you, sings to *you*, sings out your Name." **Refrain**




4. *Come* now and see the works of God, how wonderful he is in his doing *toward*
