3. Hap - py are they who dwell in your house! they will al - ways be prais - ing you.

4. Happy are the people whose strength is in you! whose hearts are set on the pil-grims' way. **Refrain**

5. Those who go through the desolate valley will find it a place of springs,
for the early rains have covered it with pools of wa - ter. 6. They will climb from height to height,
and the God of gods will reveal him - self in Zi - on. **Refrain**

Mode 8 **Refrain**

You shall draw wa-ter with re-joic-ing from the springs of sal - va-tion. -

Sure - ly it is God who saves me; I will trust in him and not be a - fraid.
