Mode 1 **Refrain**




Proclaim the great-ness of the Lord our God, who is the Ho-ly One.



1. The Lord is *King*; let the peo-ple trem-ble; he is enthroned upon the *cherubim*; let the earth shake.




2. The Lord is great in Zi-on; he is high above all peo-ples. **Refrain**



6. Mo-ses and Aaron among his *priests*, and Samuel among those who call up-on his Name,




they called upon the *Lord*, and he an-swered them. 7. He spoke to them out of the pil-lar of cloud;




they kept his testimonies and the decree that he gave them. **Refrain**
