who perse-cute you; bless and do not curse them. Re-joyce with those who


re-joyce; weep with those who weep. Live in harmo-ny with one an-other; do

not be arro-gant, but asso-ci-ate with the lowly; do not claim to be wis-er


than you are. Do not repay an-y- one e-vil for e-vil, but take thought for what

is noble in the sight of all. If it is possible, so far as it de-pends on you, live


peaceably with all. Be-lov-ed, nev-er a-venge yourselves, but leave room for




the wrath of God, for it is writ-ten, “Vengeance is mine; I will repay, says the
