



A Service of Renaming 2




For the love of Christ urges us on, because we are convinced that one

things have come in- to be- ing! All this is from God, who rec-onciled us




to himself through Christ and has giv-en us the min-istry of reconciliation;




that is, in Christ God was rec-oncil-ing the world to himself, not counting




their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to




us. So we are ambassa-dors for Christ, since God is mak-ing his appeal
