




**F** or when one says, “I be-long to Paul,” and an- other, “I be-long to A-



pol-los,” are you not all too human? What then is Apol-los? What is Paul?




Servants through whom you came to be-lieve, as the Lord assigned to each.




I planted, Apol-los wa-tered, but God gave the growth. So neither the one



who plants nor the one who wa-ters is an- ything, but only God who gives




the growth. The one who plants and the one who wa-ters have one purpose,




and each will re-ceive wag-es according to their own la-bor. For we are




God’s coworkers, working to-gether; you are God’s field, God’s build-ing.




According to the grace of God giv-en to me, like a wise master builder
