
See that none of you repays e-vil for e-vil, but always seek to do good to one




an-other and to all. Re-joyce always, pray without ceas-ing, give thanks in all




circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Je-sus for you. Do not




quench the Spir-it. Do not despise prophecies, but test everything; hold fast
