


Reaffirmation of Ordination Vows 2




Do nothing from self-ish ambi-tion or empty conceit, but in humil-




i-ty re-gard others as bet-ter than yourselves. Let each of you look not




to your own inter-ests but to the inter-ests of others. Let the same mind




be in you that was in Christ Je-sus, who, though he ex-ist-ed in the form




of God, did not re-gard equal-i-ty with God as something to be grasped,




but emptied himself, tak-ing the form of a slave, assuming hu-man likeness.
