
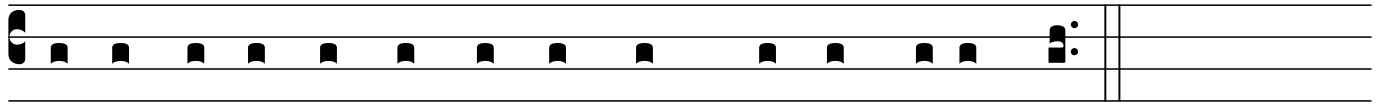


# Acts 2:42-47
