
R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* Je-sus said ‘Suppose one of you has a friend,




and you go to him at midnight and say to him, “Friend, lend me three




loaves of bread; for a friend of mine has arrived, and I have nothing to




set be-fore him.” And he answers from within, “Do not bother me;




the door has already been locked, and my children are with me in bed;




I cannot get up and give you an-ything.” I tell you, e-ven though he will




not get up and give him an-ything because he is his friend, at least because




of his persis-tence he will get up and give him what-ev-er he needs. So I




say to you, Ask, and it will be giv-en to you; search, and you will find; knock,
