
R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* They went to a place called Gethsema-ne;




and Je-sus said to his dis-ciples, ‘Sit here while I pray.’ He took with him




Pe-ter and James and John, and be-gan to be distressed and ag-i-tat-ed.




And he said to them, ‘I am deeply grieved, e-ven to death; remain here,
