
came to him, appeal-ing to him and say-ing, ‘Lord, my servant is ly- ing

have you come under my roof; but only speak the word, and my servant




will be healed. For I also am a man under author-i-ty, with soldiers un-




der me; and I say to one, “Go”, and he goes, and to an- other, “Come”,




and he comes, and to my slave, “Do this”, and the slave does it.’ When




Je-sus heard him, he was amazed and said to those who fol-lowed him,




‘Tru-ly I tell you, in no one in Isra-el have I found such faith. And to the
