




The Ho-ly Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ according to Matthew.




R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* While Je-sus was say-ing these things to them,




suddenly a leader of the syn-a-gogue came in and knelt be-fore him, say-




ing, ‘My daughter has just died; but come and lay your hand on her, and



she will live.’ And Je-sus got up and fol-lowed him, with his dis-ciples.




Then suddenly a woman who had been suffer-ing from haemorrhag-es for




twelve years came up be-hind him and touched the fringe of his cloak, for she




said to herself, ‘If I only touch his cloak, I will be made well.’ Je-sus turned,




and see- ing her he said, 'Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you




well.' And instantly the woman was made well. When Je-sus came to the lead-



er's house and saw the fluteplay-ers and the crowd mak-ing a commotion,




he said, 'Go away; for the girl is not dead but sleeping.' And they laughed
