
mae-us, a blind beggar, was sit-ting by the roadside. When he heard that



it was Je-sus of Naz-a-reth, he be-gan to shout out and say, "Je-sus, Son




of Da-vid, have mercy on me!" Man-y sternly ordered him to be qui-et,




but he cried out e-ven more loudly, "Son of Da-vid, have mercy on me!"




Je-sus stood still and said, "Call him here." And they called the blind man,



say- ing to him, “Take heart; get up, he is call- ing you.” So throwing off




his cloak, he sprang up and came to Je- sus. Then Je- sus said to him,




“What do you want me to do for you?” The blind man said to him, “My teach-
