




The Ho-ly Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ according to Luke.




R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* An expert in the law stood up to test




Je-sus. “Teacher,” he said, “what must I do to inher-it e-ternal life?”




He said to him, “What is writ-ten in the law? What do you read there?”




He answered, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and




with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind and




your neighbor as yourself.” And he said to him, “You have giv-en the right




answer; do this, and you will live.” But wanting to vindi-cate himself, he




asked Je-sus, "And who is my neighbor?" Je-sus replied, "A man was go- ing




down from Je-ru-sa-lem to Jer-icho and fell into the hands of robbers, who




stripped him, beat him, and took off, leav- ing him half dead. Now by chance




a priest was go- ing down that road, and when he saw him he passed by




on the other side. So likewise a Le- vite, when he came to the place and



saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samar- i- tan while trav- el- ing




came up- on him, and when he saw him he was moved with compassion.



He went to him and bandaged his wounds, treat- ing them with oil and wine.




Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took




care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the




innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him, and when I come back I will repay




you whatever more you spend.' Which of these three, do you think, was a
